[General information about the camp]

As of right now there's over 500 sign-ups, and we're expecting a lot of people to join during the days. This makes the camp biggest we've ever done; which leads to decisions like **not providing breakfast, and (soft)-closing sign-ups for accommodation**. We're excited to host and meet you all, and all our working groups are busy preparing for the large amount of comrades that we expect to be coming. We ask you to be patient and help us with the chaos that might come with welcoming so many.

[Arrival on Friday the 21st of February]

Especially on the arrival day we're still limited in the spaces that we have (Folketshus & Ungdomshus). There's a big punk concert until 1:00/2:00am in Ungdomshus in one of the spaces that we'll use the rest of the days. Therefore, we encourage people to meet with their hosts, get familiar with the places they're sleeping at and come back Saturday morning for a real start of the camp.

The **arrival date** will be from **14:00** on **Friday the 21st**, but don't stress it if you happen to be a little early.

[Affinity groups & Delegate structures]

We encourage everyone to form affinity groups, which are small groups between 4-15 people, that have affinity with each other on things like *risk level, communication style, trust level, types of activism* etc.

For this camp we'll be working with delegate structures, this means that we encourage affinity groups to send 1-2 people to events like the daily plenum gatherings, action and legal briefs. These people that go will then bring back information to their affinity groups. Like this we can make sure we're not too many people in our spaces at the same time.

Information presented at the daily gatherings and the legal brief will also be sent out through a Signal info channel.

[Cold Debriefs]

We encourage groups traveling from abroad to plan a cold debrief in advance for a couple of weeks after the camp. A cold debrief is a moment where you gather together to reflect and discuss what went well and what didn't and how to improve.

[Helper Chat]

We created a helper chat on Signal where we post when we need help during the camp and already before. Before you join we encourage some security measures; 1. Disconnect your phone number from signal, 2. Change your name on signal if it's your passport name, 3. Change your picture if it shows you in it.

It would be great if you can sign up as soon as possible so we can get a good overview of how many people to expect. You can also sign up as a group so not everyone has to sign up individually. For security reasons, we recommend you to not use your passport name and to use a privacy-focused e-mail as contact (such as rise-up) but you should not stress too much over it if this all sounds weird and complicated to you. We will hopefully also have time at the camp to talk about security culture in activism together.

For this camp we are working together as a coalition of activists from many different grassroots movements. Together we have agreed on a code of conduct which sets the framework for how we will share the space and care for each other during the camp. For those of you wondering what to bring, here are our suggestions of what to pack

Packing list

- Sleeping bag
- Sleeping mat
- Clothes to sleep in
- Towel
- Earplugs
- Eye mask
- Hygiene items
- Windproof clothing
- Rain poncho or rainproof clothing
- Mobil phone
- Chargers
- Pants that cover the ankles
- Socks that cover the ankles
- Preferably shoes that cover the ankles
- Long johns/leggings and thin sweaters to create layers
- Sitting pad
- Passport/national ID card or both
- Neutral keffiyeh - preferably white/black or white/red to reduce individual identification
- Neutral clothing
- Corona mask, or other mask
- Gloves/mittens
- Hand sanitizer
- Cap
- Sunglasses
- Charged power banks and chargers
- Cash for donations
- Medicine

If needed

- Loops or similar earplugs for sound vocalization regulation
- Patch from the pharmacy to bring drug-classified medicine across the street

Digital security workshop, talks by the BDS movement, the Palestinian Youth Movement, Mask of Maersk, Shut Elbit Down, Dockworkers blocking Maersk ships, workshop on antisemitism vs antizionism, banner painting, Nada(acupuncture), dancing, movie screenings, open microphone, and more.
